

# From Surrealism to Modernism

📍 Costa Brava & Barcelona landscapes

The landscapes and works of the great **Salvador Dalí** are the start of a journey during which we will not only enjoy the diverse **Catalan cuisine** but also learn how to prepare some of its most iconic dishes. The route continues to **l'Escala**, where we will sample its famous anchovies. We head inland towards **Girona**, an official **City with Character**, to explore the architectural heritage of the city, such as the Cathedral, the Jewish Quarter or the colorful houses on the River Onyar. Finally, we will get to know the ancient methods of curing foods, listen to legends or walk through **Collsacabra**, a natural landscape of mountains with dizzying cliffs, stream and waterfalls.

*It is the most emblematic hotel in the area, with a long history and renowned prestige. It is located in the old town and shopping area, just steps from important buildings like the Dalí Museum and the Toy Museum of Catalonia.*

*Wednesday. 29*  
*September*

- Nautical activity: Dinghy / kayak / paddle surf course (to choose from), in **l'Escala Yacht Club**  
*The Club Nàutic of l'Escala is very near the ruins of Empúries and the Montgrí and the Aiguamolls de l'Empordà Natural Parks. Our position allows you to explore them from a different perspective: from the sea.*
- Visit and tasting of anchovies with lunch in **Escala Museum**  
*The Anchovy and the Salt Museum shows the history of fishing and of salting oily fish from the 16th century to date, and submerges visitors in a time, a heritage and unique knowledge of the Catalan coast.*
- Guided tour in the old quarter of **Girona**  
*One of the most well-preserved medieval old town in Spain and one of the most interesting in Catalonia*
- Dinner and accommodation in Girona **Hotel Carlemany**

*Thursday. 30*  
*September*

- Transfer to L'Esquirol (Barcelona landscapes)
- **4x4 Route** through Serrallonga and Collsacabra mountains  
*The aim of the tour is to discover this natural landscape of mountains with dizzying cliffs, strams and waterfalls.*
- Lunch in Ca l'Ignasi de Cantonigròs
- Transfer to Castelldefels
- Farewell dinner in Castelldefels beach
