For what purpose and legal basis will we process your data?

The personal data requested in our form are necessary for your register as an assistant to the FReSMe Project Final Event (the Event), and therefore, if you do not want to provide us any of the personal data, it is possible that you would not assist to the Event. We will also send you reminders of the event, and relevant information about it once it has ended.

We will just process the data you include in the registration form so the legal basis of the processing is the consent you may freely give by filling the form.

How do we get your data and what data?

The data we will process about you will be gathered solely from the registration form available at www.fresme.eu and consist of the following categories of data: name, surname, work e-mail address, company or organization you work and country.

How long will we keep your data?

Your data will be processed for as long as it is necessary to manage your assistance to the Event and send you the relevant information once Event has ended. Thereafter data will not remain necessary, and we will then proceed to its deletion. However, you can revoke the consent provided at any time and the data processing will stop immediately.

Who are the recipients of your data?

Your personal data may will not be shared with any third parties/companies.

How is your personal data protected?

We are committed to keeping personal data secure, taking all reasonable precautions to do so. We implement all necessary organisational and technical measures in accordance with applicable law against unauthorised access, modification, disclosure, loss or destruction. We require and contractually impose on service providers who handle your personal data to do the same.

What are your rights?

You can revoke the consents you provide at any time. Once you have exercised your right to revocation, which will not be retroactive unless a legal provision requires it, your data may be kept blocked during the period established by the applicable regulations. You may also request Everis to confirm whether your personal data are being processed and, if so, access them. Moreover, you can request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, request their erasure when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected.

In certain circumstances, you can request the limitation of the processing of your data, in which case we will only keep them to exercise or defend against claims. You may also object to the processing of your data, in which case we will not process them, except for compelling legal reasons or to exercise or defend against possible claims. Finally, when appropriate, you can exercise your right of portability to obtain the data in electronic format or to transmit them to another entity.
